Alice Janiece Rains Walter, 93 of Hoxie died Thursday, October 27, 2022, at the Flo and Phil Jones Hospice House in Jonesboro.

Born November 30, 1928, at Bay, Arkansas, she was the daughter of the late Charles Clifton Rains and Anna Myrtle Moon Rains. At a young age, her family moved to Chicago, IL, returning to Kensett, Arkansas her junior year of high school. There she met and later married George Robert "Bert" Walter Sr. in 1950. They were married for 62 years.

She was a 1958 graduate of Southern Baptist College (Williams Baptist University) and later a graduate of Arkansas State University.

She worked as a teacher at Hoxie Elementary School, retiring with over 20 years of service. She was a member and past Worthy Matron of the Charles Chapter #410 Order of the Eastern Star, and member of the First Baptist Church of Walnut Ridge.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Bert, in 2012, one brother, Vernon Rains, and three sisters, Nina Waite, Violet Clark, and Dorothy Simpson.
