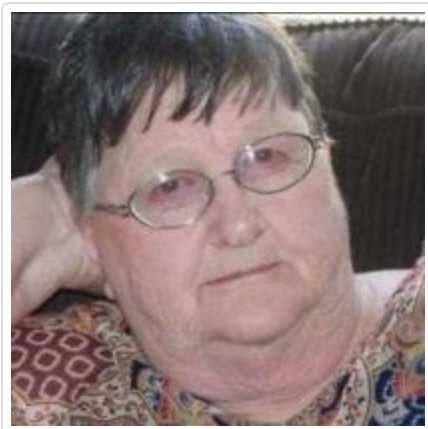




Betty Louise Bass
