Eva Inez Davis Verkler, 91, of Black Rock passed away on Friday, April 26, 2013 at the Flo and Phil Jones Hospice House in Jonesboro.

She was born November 25, 1921 in Fairview Community near Imboden and was the daughter of Albert and Ina Janes Davis. She was a homemaker and a member of the United Methodist Church in Black Ark. In later years she worshipped at the Koinonia Christian Fellowship in Imboden. She was very devoted to her Christian faith.

She was united in marriage to Glen Verkler on Dec 28, 1939. They remained faithfully and lovingly married for almost 68 years until his death in 2007.

Eva and Glen lived in Kansas City, Kansas, for about 15 years before returning to Black Rock in 1964. She was an active volunteer in Youth for Christ, a member of circles and women's groups wherever she attended church.

She was a devoted homemaker and a wonderful cook who welcomed family and friends to her home whenever they arrived. Nobody was ever turned away and nobody left hungry. She was a 4-H leader in Black Rock when her children were growing up. Later she discovered an interest in art, including oil

painting and ceramics.

She was preceded in death by her parents; one sister, Susie Savage; and five brothers, Herschel, Harry, Walt, Ray, and Larry.

Survivors include one brother, Neal Davis and his wife, Katherine, of Kansas City, Kan.; two sons, Ron Verkler and his wife, Liz, of Kansas City, Mo., and Mark Verkler and his wife, Mdrie, of Wylie, Texas; two daughters, Jan Meier of Wylie, Texas, and Rhonda Turbyville and her husband, Scott, of Portia; 15 grandchildren; nine great-grandchildren; and many other relatives and friends. She was a beloved mother, a cherished grandmother, a dear aunt, and a devoted friend who will be missed forever.

The funeral took place at 3 p.m. April 29 at Koinonia Christian Fellowship in Imboden, Pastor Joe Loghry officiating. Burial is in Oak Forest Cemetery in Black Rock.
