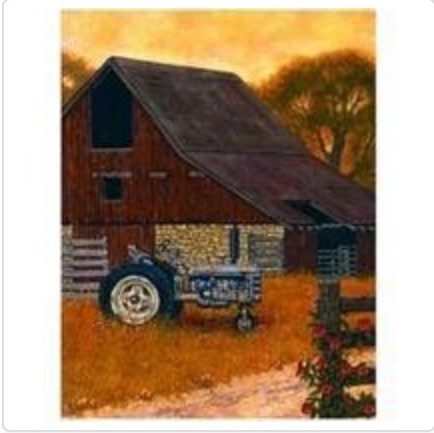




Gene McCormic
