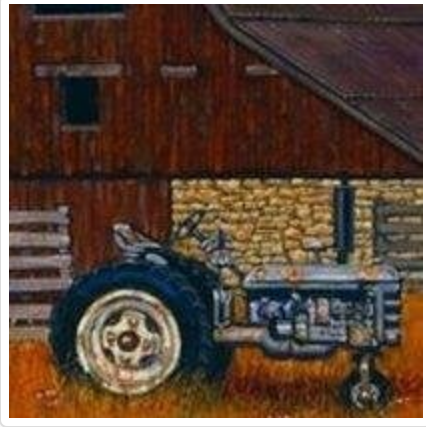




James R. Finch
