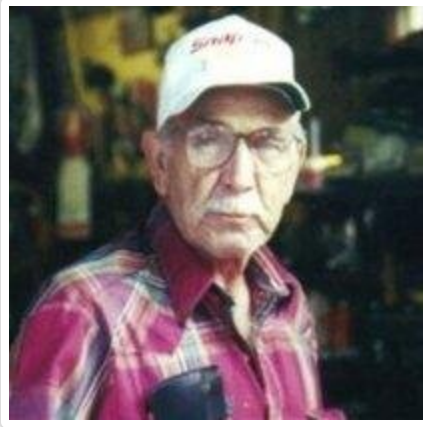




Lex Ward
