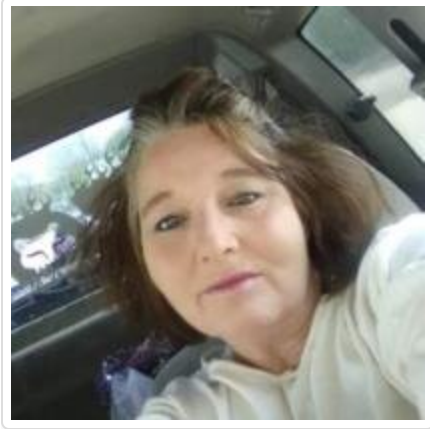




Melissa Jo Taylor

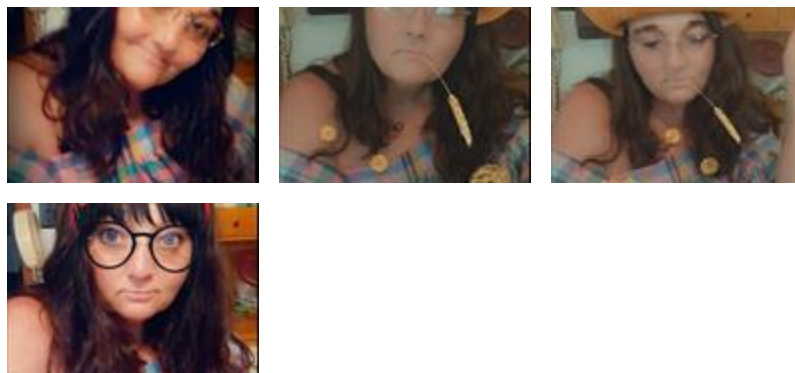
