June 2, 1921 - May 23, 2016

Mildred Irene Warner Manning Bridges died Monday May 23, 2016 in O'Fallon, Illinois.

She was born June 2, 1921 in Walnut Ridge, Arkansas where she was a longtime resident, and also resided in Memphis, Tennessee for several years.

In Walnut Ridge, Arkansas, Mrs. Bridges, known then as Mrs. Manning, taught school for 36 years in the Walnut Ridge Public School System, touching the lives of many of the community's young people. In addition to her love of teaching, Mrs. Bridges loved playing bridge, gardening, and was passionate about her family.

Mrs. Bridges was three times a widow who had been married to the late Raymond Manning of Walnut Ridge, and then to the late Leonard Sharp, of Walnut Ridge, and later to the late Dr. James Taylor Bridges of Memphis, Tennessee. She is preceded in death by her son Danny Jerome Manning and sister Fern Hawley.
