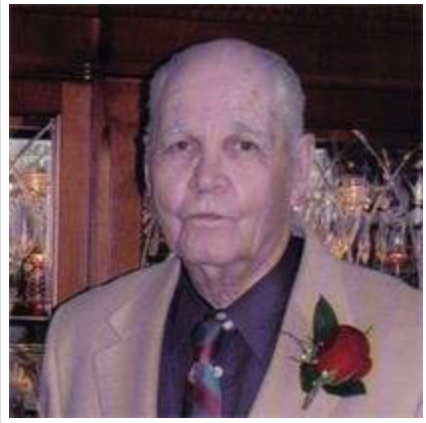




Robert Neely
