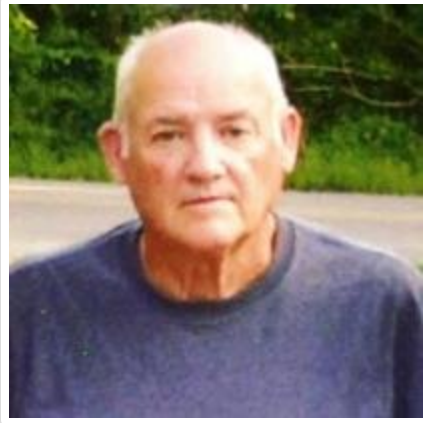




William Morris Nunally
